The 1st May starts the busiest period in the examinations calendar for the countries in the northern hemisphere. This month, we are marking scripts mainly from Russia, Holland, Italy, Vietnam and the UK and making sure that the next papers for a variety of countries from Azerbaijan to Italy, from Holland to Macau and from Cyprus to Xplore in the east of England are all present and correct on the day for their important exam sessions.

We have also had great news confirming our recognition in both Spain and Greece.

News from Anglia Network Europe

Slovenia

Seven pupils from the Netherlands will travel to Slovenia on 3rd May where they will stay with host families. From Monday to Thursday they will attend classes with their host brother/sister. For classes such as maths, geography, science etc. they will be switched to the international department of the school where all the lessons are taught in English.

In the afternoon they will be picked up at the school by a group of seven students from the University of Ljubljana (Faculty of Education). They will

organize afternoon activities in English including a trip to Austria. In August, the Slovenian host students will come to The Netherlands, to take part in the English Summer Schools.



Spain

On Saturday 2 May a group of 10 students from different Anglia Schools will travel to our English Summer School in Bilbao (Spain). It will be a totally 'English Experience' in a Spanish setting. Students will attend English lessons, at their level. They will also receive selected English lessons from the Step To Books at their appropriate level from Anglia Teachers.

In addition, students will be given various assignments during the week in order to make a short, punchy digital video report. Various daytime activities and excursions are included.

NEW IN 2015 – Anglia Exams Online Registration system, now available!

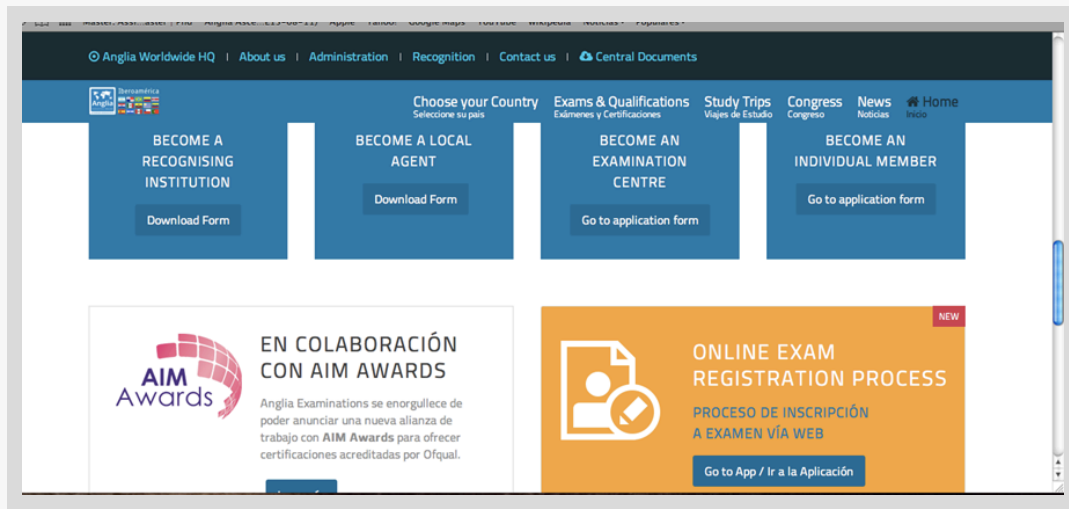
